Saint of the Month

St. Ferdinand III of Castile - May 30th

Born around 1201, the son of the King of Leon (western Spain) and the Princess of Castile (eastern Spain), St. Ferdinand first inherited Castile from his uncle in 1217. Then in 1230 he inherited Leon despite a messy dispute with his father and his sisters over the succession of the crown, uniting the two country's that eventually became Spain. While king he was greatly involved in the wars against the Muslim moors in the south, achieving great victories which he gave credit to the Virgin Mary. Eventually, all except a very small kingdom of Granada in Spain was liberated and the pope gave him the title Champion of Christ. While not in battle, St. Ferdinand was known as a just and wise ruler, ensuring that his people had low taxes and justice was administered at all levels to society even to the poorest. As a third order Franciscan, St. Ferdinand also ensured his people's spiritual health by founding hospitals, monasteries and two new Cathedrals in his realm along with the University of Salamanca, the finest in Spain. He was also known as a kind husband to his wives Queen Beatrice (1219-1236) and Joan (1236-1252) and a great father to his ten children. He died in 1252 of natural causes and was canonized in 1671. St. Ferdinand is the patron saint of engineers along with St. Patrick.
